**ORDER ON RECEIVER'S THIRD APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE  
AND PAYMENT OF FEES AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE  
RECEIVER, RETAINED COUNSEL, AND OTHER PROFESSIONALS**

This matter is before the Court on the *Receiver's Third Application for Allowance and Payment of Expenses Incurred by the Receiver, Retained Counsel, and Other Professionals* (the "Application") filed by Claire M. Schenk, in her capacity as receiver ("Receiver") for Defendants Global Access Technical Support LLC ("GATS"), Global sMind LLC ("Global sMind"), Source Pundit LLC ("Source Pundit"), and Helios Digital Media LLC ("Helios") (collectively, the "Receivership Defendants"), on August \_\_, 2017. The Receiver submitted the Application to the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") for review before filing it with the Court.

In the Application, the Receiver seeks a total award of \$50,860.41, consisting of: (a) \$49,092.66 in legal fees and costs for Thompson Coburn LLP, the Receiver's primary counsel; (b) \$1,216.75 in professional fees and costs for Segue Partners, LLC, the Receiver's bookkeeper; and (c) \$551.00 in professional fees for CliftonLarsonAllen LLP, the Receiver's accountant, tax preparer, forensics and valuation expert.

The Court has reviewed the Application and supporting documentation and concludes

that the requested fees and costs are reasonable and appropriate.

Having fully considered the Application and being duly advised as to the merits,


**THE COURT DOES HEREBY ORDER THAT**

1. The Receiver's Application is granted in its entirety;

2. The Receiver is authorized to make payment of the total amount of legal and professional fees and incurred costs out of the assets of the Receivership estate as follows:

- (a) \$49,051.79 in legal fees and \$40.87 in costs for Thompson Coburn LLP, the Receiver's primary counsel;
- (b) \$1,201.50 in professional fees and \$15.25 in costs for Segue Partners, LLC, the Receiver's bookkeeper; and
- (c) \$551.00 in professional fees for CliftonLarsonAllen LLP, the Receiver's accountant, tax preparer, forensics and valuation expert.
